

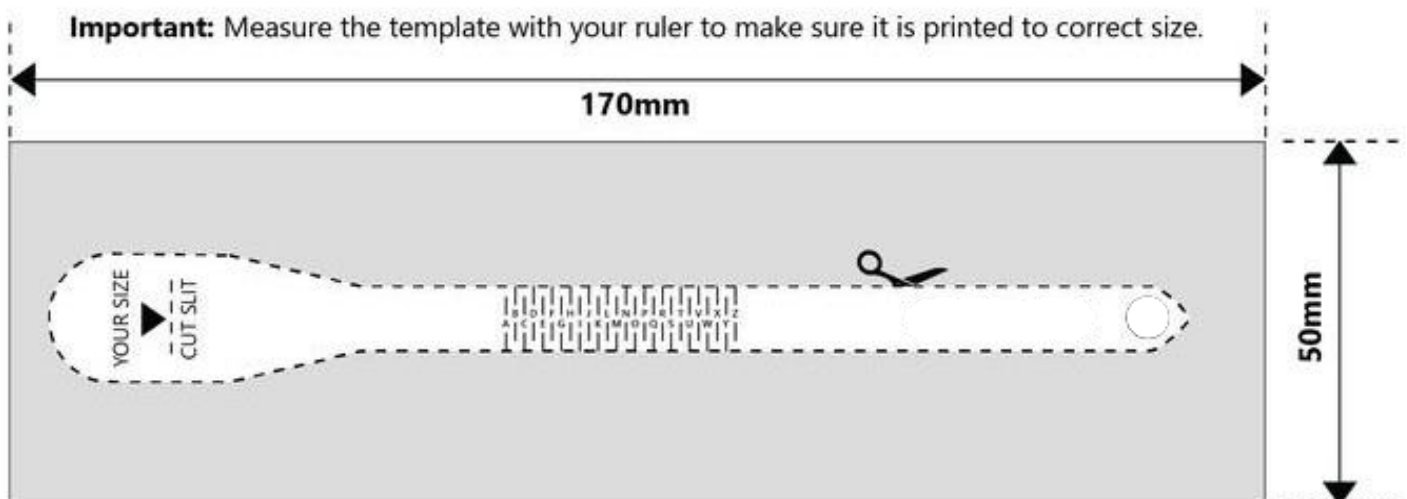
How to find your ring size



Please note that this chart must be printed to work correctly and should not be used directly from a screen. When printing, ensure your print settings are set to Actual Size or 100%. After printing, use a ruler to confirm that the reference line measures exactly 170 mm to ensure the chart has printed accurately. This sizing guide is based on Australian ring sizes, and measurements are intended as a guide only. Rings created using this method may still require adjustment by a professional jeweller.

Method 1: Wrap Around Ring Sizer

1. Carefully cut out the ring sizer along the outer edge.
2. Using a small blade or scissors, create a slit where indicated on the sizer.
3. Wrap the strip around the finger you wish to measure, ensuring the letters remain visible on the outside.
4. Feed the pointed end of the strip through the slit and gently tighten it until it sits comfortably around the widest part of your finger, usually near the knuckle.
5. Check the letter size that lines up with the slit opening. If the measurement falls between two sizes, choose the **larger size** for a more comfortable fit.

It is important to make sure you have your ring size measured professionally before making a purchase.

Method Two: Measure Using an Existing Ring

1. Select a ring that already fits comfortably on the finger you intend to measure.
2. Place the ring over the size circles provided until you find the closest match.
The circle should align with the **inside edge** of the ring, not the outside.
3. Once you find the best match, note the **letter shown inside the circle** as your estimated Australian ring size.
